When

Host your diaper drive for at least a week or longer, so people have time to purchase diapers and drop-off. Make sure the start and end date are clearly communicated.

2

Where

Choose a centrally located, high traffic spot or multiple spots for diaper drop-off. Post the "Diaper Drop-off Here" signs included in this kit.



3

Goal

Set a predetermined, obtainable goal. This is an excellent way to spark participation. Use a goal chart. Create incentives. Make it a competition.



Promote

Use social media, newsletters, email announcements, and flyers. See Communication Samples on the next page for easy posts, texts, and emails and use the flyer included in this kit.

The Villages stats in 2021...



1,828 families were served by our Healthy Families program, with almost 100% having a child in diapers.

10% of Older Youth Services participants (youth aged out of foster care) had at least one child in diapers.



According to the National Diaper Bank Network...

Children need a minimum of 50 diaper changes per week.

The average monthly cost of diapers is between \$70 and \$80 per child.

Federal and state programs (like SNAP or WIC) do not cover diapers.

Babies who remain too long in a soiled diaper are exposed to **potential** health risks.

Diaper Drive Coordinator Checklist

Follow these 10 simple steps to ensure a successful diaper drive.

- 1. Choose your Diaper Drive location.
- 2. **Recruit** volunteers to help promote, count, collect, and deliver diapers.
- 3. **Select** a start and end date.
- 4. **Set** your diaper collection goal, theme, and/or incentives.
- 5. Prep your drop off location with visible signs.
- 6. **Promote** the diaper drive!
- 7. **Confirm** transportation for diaper delivery and Villages' office availability to accept diapers.
