STEPS TO A SUCCESSFUL DRIVE

When

Host your school supply drive for a week or longer, so people have time to purchase items and drop-off. Make sure the start and end date are clearly communicated.



2 Where Choose a centrally located, high traffic spot or multiple spots for donation drop, off. Post the "Culture to an ultiple spots for donation drop-off. Post the "School Supply Drop-off Here" signs included in this kit.

3 Goal Set a predetermined, obtainable goal. This is an excellent way to spark participation. Use a goal chart. Create incentives. Make it a competition.
